



Get Paid While Serving The Tigua Community



The Pueblo is recruiting 2 members to serve on a part-time basis to the Target Tigua AmeriCorps Program. The program will provide the YDSP community with resources to help improve lives, build the community, and foster civic engagement. Members will serve part time which is at least 900 hours during a year. Members are eligible for a living allowance up to \$7,125 designed to help meet the necessary living expenses incurred while participating in the Target Tigua Program. Members are also eligible for a college scholarship upon completing the service term. Positions are available for the below mentioned programs. To be considered follow the “How to Apply” instructions.

- **Entrepreneur Training Assistant (1 position)** - Under the direction of the host site supervisor, the Entrepreneur Training Assistant offers small business development services, conducts small business and economic research, develops curriculum, materials and presentations, recruits clients, participates in entrepreneur training, and designs and disseminates marketing materials about the program.
- **Tigua VITA Coordinator (1 position)** - The Tigua VITA Coordinator will assist the Tribal Empowerment Department coordinate all activities in providing free tax preparation services to low income families of El Paso County for purposes of joining the economic mainstream by promoting the effective use of their earned income tax credit, child tax credit and education credits with long-term asset development objectives.

How to Apply:

- Select “Search Listings”
- The listing criteria will be “Texas” under state and “Target Tigua” under program name.
- Select “Apply to Serve” and fill out the profile.
- Completion of the user profile will prompt an email response from AmeriCorps.
- Follow the directions on the email to complete the online application process.
- Print two copies of your online application.

Eligibility Requirements:

- U.S. Citizen, U.S. National, or Lawful Permanent Resident of the United States
- 18 Years or Older
- A High School Diploma or Equivalency
- Must Pass a Background Check (does not always disqualify)
- Must demonstrate a sincere interest in serving the Ysleta del Sur Pueblo
- Must have minimum skills and knowledge to complete project tasks and objectives
- Have reliable transportation
