Items Accepted:

- Paper (Newspapers, junk mail, cereal and dry food boxes (without liner) paperback and hardback books, cardboard egg cartons, phone books, catalogs)
 - Plastics 1-7 (Milk, juice, soda and other beverage containers, shampoo and conditioner bottles and caps, detergent and fabric softener bottles, and plastic bags)
 - Metal (Soda and other aluminum, cans, canned food cans and lids, aluminum foil, and clothes hangers)
 - Flattened Cardboard
- **Recyclables should not contain food residue. Please rinse!**

Not accepted:

- Yard Waste
- Food Waste
- Tires
- Glass
- Styrofoam or packing peanuts
- Clothes, shoes and clothing
- Wax or plastic coated boxes
- Soiled paper or tissue
- Light bulbs or batteries
- Electronic waste (can be picked up, make appointment with EMO)
