



Traditional Foot Race

All Tribal families please join us for the Traditional Foot Race to start off the agricultural/growing season for 2014.

- Race will be Ia Kitu (Corn Village) vs. P'a Kitu (Pumpkin Village).
- Located along the agricultural fields between the back of the houses of Tomas Granillo and the Border fence.
- The race will be a relay race of 300 yards between 12 men: 6 from Ia Kitu and 6 from P'a Kitu.
- The diffancio or winner will be presented with corn and other gifts.
- Women are asked to bring a covered dish for a feast after the completion of the race, and must wear a skirt.
- Please bring blankets and lawn chairs for the feast after completion of race.
- Men 13 and up may compete. Men from Ia Kitu are asked to wear blue shorts and men from P'a Kitu are asked to wear red shorts both are shirtless, mocassins or tennis shoes.
