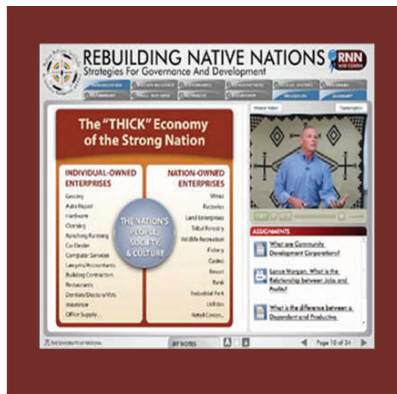


REBUILDING NATIVE NATIONS: STRATEGIES FOR GOVERNANCE AND DEVELOPMENT



Ysleta del Sur Pueblo is pleased to announce that it is working with the Native Nations Institute to pilot *Rebuilding Native Nations: Strategies for Governance and Development* a distance-learning course. This course is meant to help tribal nations, like Ysleta del Sur Pueblo, to look at the challenges facing tribes and provide a roadmap for improving their communities, governments and economies.

The Economic Development Department is searching for Tigua community members to participate in the course and learn how tribes across the nation are strategically planning and implementing new polices to create better futures for their people.



The course uses an easy to follow electronic-based lesson plan and the *Rebuilding Native Nations* textbook (University of Arizona Press, 2007). The course is expected to take approximately 20 hours to complete and you can learn at your own pace. All participants will receive a completion certificate from the University of Arizona Native Nations Institute.
