POSITION SUMMARY:

The Electrician Installs, maintains, and repairs electrical wiring, equipment, and fixtures in accordance of applicable codes and safety regulations. Duties include but are not limited to: plans layout and installation of electrical wiring, equipment, or fixtures based on job specifications and local codes; connects wires to circuit breakers, transformers, or other components; test electrical systems or continuity of circuits in electrical wiring, equipment or fixtures using testing devices to ensure compatibility and safety of system; inspects electrical systems, equipment or components to identify hazards, defects or need for adjustment or repair; inspects assigned work order of subordinates to ensure accuracy, completeness and quality of work; develops and maintains a scheduled maintenance service on electrical systems and fixtures; directs and trains workers to install, maintain, or repair electrical wiring or equipment; maintains records of work assignments and databases to generate reports; assists other Property Management sub-divisions such as the Custodial, Housing, Plumbing, Facilities, or Roads & Grounds team; other position related duties as required and assigned.

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS:

- High School Diploma or its equivalent, GED;
- Associates degree in electrical technology or 7 years of related experience and/or training;
- Journeyman Electrician license recognized by the Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation;
- Must possess a valid Texas Driver License and be insurable;
- Must be able to successfully pass a post offer criminal history background check.

KNOWLEDGE, SKILLS, ABILITIES:

Knowledge of National Electrical Codes and best practices; knowledge of building codes, legislation, regulations, policies and procedures installation and maintenance; knowledge of design technique, tools, and principles involved in the production of precision technical plans, blueprints, drawings and models; knowledge of standard construction safety practices and procedures; knowledge of Microsoft Office software such as Word and Excel; ability to read blueprints that include technical diagrams of electrical systems; analytical skills and ability to identify problems and take appropriate corrective action measures; ability to effectively train and supervise electrician apprenticeship candidates; ability to maintain electrician's license; ability to work cooperatively with other trades; effective verbal and written communication skills; time management skills, and ability to read and interpret drawings, specification and blueprints.
