Central Storm water operation center: 410 S. Cotton, 8-5 pm, M through F.

Four other sites:

West side - 120 Kappa near Keystone Park, 9-8pm, M through F

North side - Nations Tobin Park, 8831 Railroad, 9-8pm, M through F

East side - Album Park Wedgewood and Lockerbie, 2-8pm, M through F

Lower Valley - Blackie Chester Park, 9144 Escobar, 2-8pm, M through F

Hours will be extended at all sites during major storms and will include weekend hours. There is a limit of 25 bags per visit.
