TIGUA EDUCATIONAL TECHNOLOGY

In response to the COVID-19 pandemic, the Pueblo is sponsoring a distance learning initiative aimed at bridging the gap you may be experiencing due to current shifts in education methods. Through its *Tigua Educational Technology (EdTech) Initiative*, the Department of Tribal Empowerment, in an effort to support the continuum of educational achievement, will provide a FREE laptop to all tribal students. The laptops will be equipped with basic Microsoft Office applications to assist in distance learning. Required documentation to confirm eligibility must be submitted through Google Forms. Access to the forms is provided through links under Required Documents. Application processing time may take up to 4 weeks.
